১. আগ্রহ, রুচি বা অনুরাগ (Interest/Liking)

Interest in (আগ্রহ)

He has a keen interest in financial markets.

Zest for (তীব্র উৎসাহ)

She has an incredible zest for life.

Liking for (পছন্দ)

The panel has a special liking for innovative ideas.

Fondness for (প্রিয়তা/অনুরাগ)

He has a strange fondness for old novels.

Penchant for (বিশেষ ঝোঁক)

The CEO has a penchant for micro-management.

Taste for (রুচি)

He has no taste for classical literature.

Appetite for (ক্ষুধা/আকাঙ্ক্ষা)

Foreign investors have a huge appetite for tech stocks.

Passion for (আবেগ/তীব্র টান)

Her passion for research earned her the scholarship.

২. দক্ষতা বা পারদর্শিতা (Skilled/Expert)

Good at (দক্ষ)

He is exceptionally good at analytical puzzles.

Adept in/at (পারদর্শী)

She is adept in managing cross-functional teams.

Proficient in (দক্ষ/পটু)

Applicants must be proficient in business communication.

Expert in/at (বিশেষজ্ঞ)

He is a verified expert in corporate law.

Versed in (অভিজ্ঞ/সুবিজ্ঞ)

The lawyer is well versed in constitutional matters.

At home in (দক্ষ/স্বাচ্ছন্দ্যময়)

He is quite at home in advanced statistics.

৩. অদক্ষতা বা অপটুতা (Unskilled/Incompetent)

Bad at (অদক্ষ)

He is notoriously bad at public speaking.

Dull at (কোণা/ঘীর)

The student is a bit dull at rapid calculations.

Inept at (অনুপযুক্ত/অপটু)

The new manager proved to be inept at conflict resolution.

৪. উপকারী বা সহায়ক (Beneficial/Helpful)

Beneficial to (উপকারী)

Low tax rates are beneficial to small startups.

Conducive to (সহায়ক)

A quiet working space is conducive to productivity.

Congenial to (উপযোগী/অনুকূল)

The climate of the country is congenial to his health.

৫. ক্ষতিকর বা ধ্বংসাত্মক (Harmful/Destructive)

Harmful to (ক্ষতিকর)

Smoking is deeply harmful to health.

Detrimental to (ক্ষতিকর/অপকারী)

Internal conflicts are detrimental to company growth.

Deleterious to (ক্ষতিকারক)

Toxic emissions are deleterious to the atmosphere.

Derogatory to (সম্মানহানিকর)

Do not make remarks that are derogatory to anyone's character.

৬. বিরত থাকা বা বাধা দেওয়া (Abstain/Prevent)

Abstain from (বিরত থাকা)

Voters were urged to abstain from violence.

Refrain from (ক্ষান্ত থাকা)

Please refrain from using cell phones inside the hall.

Prevent from (বাধা দেওয়া)

The heavy rain prevented us from leaving the office.

Prohibit from (নিষিদ্ধ করা)

The law prohibits individuals from carrying firearms here.

৭. অবাক, বিস্মিত বা উপহাস করা (Surprised/Mock)

Astonished at (বিস্মিত)

Everyone was astonished at his sudden resignation.

Surprised at (অবাক)

I am not at all surprised at the outcome.

Laugh at / Mock at (উপহাস করা)

Never laugh at a poor man's condition.

৮. অভিযোগ, দোষারোপ বা নির্দোষ (Accuse/Guilt)

Accuse of (অভিযুক্ত করা)

The accountant was accused of fraud.

Guilty of (দোষী)

The jury found him guilty of tax evasion.

Innocent of (নির্দোষ)

She is completely innocent of the charges.

Note: Charge with (অভিযুক্ত), Blame for (দায়ী) /

৯. যোগ্য বা উপযুক্ত (Fit/Eligible)

Eligible for (যোগ্য)

Only postgraduates are eligible for this corporate post.

Fit for (উপযুক্ত)

The ruined house is no longer fit for human habitation.

Note: Worthy of, Deserving of (যোগ্য/ উপযুক্ত) /

১০. বিখ্যাত বা সুপরিচিত (Famous/Well-known)

Famous for (বিখ্যাত)

Paris is famous for its magnificent architecture.

Renowned for (সুপরিচিত)

The professor is renowned for his microeconomic theories.

Notorious for (কুখ্যাত)

The company is notorious for delaying salaries.

১১. নতি স্বীকার বা আত্মসমর্পণ (Submit/Surrender)

Yield to (নতি স্বীকার করা)

Do not yield to unjust political pressure.

Surrender to (আত্মসমর্পণ করা)

The fugitives finally surrendered to the police.

Succumb to (দাখিল হওয়া/মারা যাওয়া)

He sadly succumbed to his severe injuries.

১২. লেগে থাকা বা অটল থাকা (Stick to/Adhere)

Adhere to (লেগে থাকা)

All employees must strictly adhere to the code of conduct.

Stick to (অটল থাকা)

If you want to pass, stick to your study routine.

১৩. অভাব, শূন্য বা বঞ্চিত (Lack/Devoid)

Devoid of (বর্জিত/শূন্য)

The statement is completely devoid of truth.

Deprived of (বঞ্চিত)

The refugees were deprived of basic healthcare.

Short of (ঘাটতি)

We are currently running a bit short of funds.

Note: Deficient in, Wanting in (অভাব/কমতি) /

১৪. পরিপূর্ণ বা ভরা (Full of/Filled with)

Full of (পূর্ণ)

The hall room was full of enthusiastic candidates.

Filled with (পরিপূর্ণ)

Her eyes were suddenly filled with tears.

Teeming with (ভরাট/পূর্ণ)

The Sundarbans is teeming with diverse wildlife.

Infested with (উপদ্রুত/কীটপতঙ্গ দ্বারা পূর্ণ)

The old warehouse is infested with rats.

১৫. উদাসীন বা ক্রম্বেপহীন (Indifferent/Callous)

Indifferent to (উদাসীন)

He remains totally indifferent to my warnings.

Callous to (কঠোর/অক্ষিপহীন)

How can you be so callous to the sufferings of the poor?

Regardless of (নির্বিশেষে)

The rule applies to all candidates, regardless of their background.

১৬. সচেতন বা সতর্ক (Aware/Careful)

Aware of / Conscious of (সচেতন)

You must be aware of your legal rights.

Beware of (সতর্ক হওয়া)

Beware of pickpockets in crowded buses.

১৭. অজ্ঞ বা অসচেতন (Ignorant/Unaware)

Ignorant of (অজ্ঞ)

He was completely ignorant of the newly implemented laws.

Oblivious of (বিস্মৃত/অসচেতন)

He was completely oblivious of the hidden dangers.

১৮. খোঁজ করা বা অনুসন্ধান (Search/Look for)

Look for / Search for (খোঁজা)

They are looking for a new corporate workspace.

In quest of (সন্ধানে)

The scholars traveled far in quest of ancient knowledge.

১৯. ভীত বা আতঙ্কিত (Afraid/Fearful)

Afraid of (ভীত)

She is afraid of failure in competitive setups.

Terrified of (আতঙ্কিত)

The child was terrified of the sudden loud noise.

২০. আকাঙ্ক্ষা বা তীব্র ইচ্ছা (Desire/Crave)

Hanker after (পিছনে ছোটা)

Do not hanker after cheap popularity.

Long for / Yearn for (আকাঙ্ক্ষা করা)

The exiled leader longed for his beloved homeland.

২১. তুলনা বা সমতুল্য (Compare/Equal)

Compare to / with (তুলনা করা)

Do not compare this year's result with the previous one.

Prefer to (পছন্দ করা)

I prefer tea to coffee in the morning.

Superior to / Inferior to (উচ্চতর/নিম্নতর)

This model is far superior to the older version.

Tantamount to (সমতুল্য)

His silence is tantamount to an open confession.

২২. নির্ভর বা আস্থা (Depend/Rely)

Depend on / Rely on (নির্ভর করা)

The success of the project depends on team coordination.

Count on (গণনা করা/নির্ভর)

You can always count on my full support.

২৩. সদৃশ বা সমান (Similar/Alike)

Similar to (সদৃশ)

His writing style is quite similar to that of Orwell.

Identical to / with (অভিন্ন)

The two reports are almost identical to each other.

২৪. ভিন্ন বা বিপরীত (Different/Opposite)

Different from (ভিন্ন)

The real scenario is vastly different from what was reported.

Contrary to (বিপরীত)

Contrary to popular belief, the project was highly profitable.

২৫. জড়িত বা নিমগ্ন (Involved/Absorbed)

Absorbed in / Engrossed in (নিমগ্ন)

He was deeply engrossed in checking the annual balance sheets.

২৬. গর্বিত বা অহংকারী (Proud/Boastful)

Proud of / Boastful of (গর্বিত)

She is not at all boastful of her recent academic achievements.

Note: Pride in (Noun): She takes great pride in her corporate heritage.

২৭. বিশ্বাস বা আস্থা (Believe/Trust)

Believe in / Faith in (আস্থা)

Have absolute faith in your consistent hard work.

২৮. সীমাবদ্ধ বা আবদ্ধ (Confined/Limited)

Confined to (সীমাবদ্ধ)

The severe illness kept him confined to bed for a full week.

২৯. শোক বা বিলাপ (Mourn/Lament)

Mourn for / Lament for (শোক করা)

They mourned for the lost lives in the sudden factory fire.

Sympathy for (ସହାନୁଭୂତି)

We have deep corporate sympathy for the affected victims.

Die of (রোগ)

Die from (বাহ্যিক কারণ/অতিরিক্ত)

He died from overeating.

Die by (আত্মহত্যা)

He died by suicide.

Die in (যুদ্ধ/দারিদ্র্য)

The soldier died in battle.

2. Agree (রাজি হওয়া)

Agree with (ব্যক্তি)

I completely agree with your business opinion.

Agree to (প্রস্তাব)

They readily agreed to our new proposal.

Agree on (বিষয়)

Finally, they agreed on the terms of the contract.

3. Angry / Annoyed

Angry with (ব্যক্তি)

The boss is extremely angry with the executive.

Angry at (আচরণ)

He was extremely angry at her rude behavior.

4. Familiar

Familiar to (কারো নিকট)

This strategy is quite familiar to us.

Familiar with (জ্ঞাত)

He is very familiar with the exam layout.

5. Blind

Blind of / in (চোখ)

The old man is blind of one eye.

Blind to (দোষ)

The management is completely blind to their faults.
